Each business owner must comply with the California Health and Safety Code and California Code of Regulations regarding the use and handling of hazardous materials.

**Penalty: Any business that violates Section 25540 of the Health and Safety Code shall be civilly liable to the administering agency in an amount of not more than \$2,000 for each day in which the violation occurs. If the violation results in, or significantly contributes to an emergency, including a fire, the business shall also be assessed the full cost of the County emergency response, as well as the cost of cleaning up and disposing of the hazardous materials.**
